If you don't know your riding, our student volunteers will help you. Just ask. Here is a quick reminder, so listen up: Students from Thorold, Thorold South, and the Vansickle area--you will vote for the NIAGARA CENTRE riding. Students from Merriton and South St. Catharines--you will vote for the ST. CATHARINES riding. Students from Western Hill, Jordan, Vineland--you will vote for the NIAGARA WEST riding. Finally, for all you 18 year olds - be sure to VOTE ON THURSDAY. It is now your DUTY and OBLIGATION as a Canadian adult. So, be an adult, take your photo ID to the closest polling station and mark your ballot. Thank you Reds' Nation and see you at the polls!</p>
