Excerpt from the Denis Morris Catholic School Council By-Laws (Section 3 – Membership)

Parent Member of the Denis Morris Catholic School Council:

Custodial parents/guardians of the students enrolled in the school (elected by parents and guardians) must reside within the boundaries of the school or have Board permission to attend the school.

A person is not qualified to be a parent member of the Catholic School Council if,

i) he/she is employed at the school;

or

ii) he/she is employed elsewhere by the Board and fails to take reasonable steps to inform voters of that employment. This disclosure can be made on the DMCS self-nomination form.

or

iii) he/she misses more than 3 consecutive meetings without a reasonable written explanation being provided to the Denis Morris Catholic School Council on or before his/her third consecutive absence. The basis for the absence will be reviewed by the Denis Morris Catholic School Council Chair and the Denis Morris Catholic High School Principal, a determination made and subsequently communicated in writing to the member. Such absence will result in the loss of voting status while allowing the member to retain "observer status only" for the remainder of the current term, thus allowing for adjustment to our voting membership with respect to quorum; recognizing that all Denis Morris School Council meetings are open to the public and all parent/guardians of students attending Denis Morris Catholic High School as "observers".
